Region: Milton, Nova Scotia

Formation: 4 couples in a square

Measures:	Counts:	Pattern:
		Introduction
		The Dance
1 – 4	1 – 8	Head Lady chain to the Right. (Do not chain back)
5 – 8	9 – 16	The 4 Ladies dance a Grand Chain. (The 4 ladies give R hands in the middle for a Right hand star half-way around to the opposite Man, give him a Left hand and he courtesy turns the lady.)
9 – 12	17 -24	The new head Ladies chain to the Right.
13 – 16	25 – 32	The 4 Ladies dance a Grand Chain (as in measures 5 – 8). All 4 Ladies should now be in their original places.
17 – 24	33 – 48	The 4 Men dance a Left hand star $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around and swing the Lady they meet.
25 – 32	49 – 64	Promenade the new Lady once around the set and end in the Lady's position. (In this dance it is always the ladies who return to home base at the end of the promenade, while the men have a new home place as well as a new partner each time through the dance.)

Repeat the dance again for the Head Couples, then do it twice for the side couples.
