The Winter Is Over

Musical notation for 'The Winter Is Over' in G major, 4/4 time. The first system contains 8 measures with a repeat sign after the 4th measure. The second system contains 4 measures with a repeat sign after the 2nd measure. Chords are indicated below the notes.

Chords: G, D, G, D7, G, G, Am, G, Am, D7, G, D, G(Em), Am, Dm, G

Waters of Holland: :Longways for 3 couples - 2nd couple improper.

A1 All lead forward and back a double.

A2 Change hands and lead down and back a double

B1 1st Man face 2nd Man and 2nd Woman face 3rd Woman - set Rt and left - change places passing rt shoulder - everyone swing with pivot step 1 and a half with one partner

B2 1st Woman face 3rd Woman whilst 1st Man and 3rd Man do the same:

Set and change places and pivot swing as before.

2nd Fig: Siding as Pat Shaw- right shoulder to right shoulder and left shoulder to left shoulder and repeat the setting and swing.

3rd Fig: Arming right and left and repeat crossing etc. when all should be home.

N.B. The crossing is always from the same position - i.e. the top two on the Men's side face the bottom two on the Women's side.
