Secretary's Report to News

At the last AGM there was some discussion about future General Meetings. One of the results is the EGM to be held at Swansea on July 25 during the Summer School week. The committee look forward to receiving contributions and ideas from a much larger assembly of members than is usually seen at an AGM. We will also be issuing an invitation to members from regions outside of London to volunteer to host the 2005 AGM (this must take place in November or December 2005), with perhaps an accompanying event. John Douglas will stand for election as Chairman at the EGM.

The 2004 AGM will be held at 4.30 Nov 20th in Trefusis, at Cecil Sharp House in London. It will follow a Saturday SIFD day course and we hope this will tempt more members to attend.

In the first part of this year we have been looking at setting up an underwriting policy that benefits both the Society as a whole as well as groups seeking to hold events. The Teachers List is being restructured to distinguish between different categories of teachers, and a system introduced that will keep the list current and up to date. We hope to be able to report a successful outcome from our negotiations with the Charity Commission with regard to the remuneration of Trustees in the not too distant future.

Regretfully, we must announce that Simon Guest has resigned as Minutes Secretary. He has performed this not always easy task for eight years. All the members of the committee will miss him and wish to thank him for his valued service (and would be delighted if he reconsidered).

LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Dear Heather,

I thought the good folks who read the S.I.F.D. News might be interested in hearing something about our group.

The Lewes Israeli Folk Dance Group was started out of a desire to do the more demanding Israeli folk dances, which is not always possible in local dance groups, with the policy of encouraging anyone to 'bring and share' their favourite dances. As a consequence, it attracts keen Israeli folk dancers from a wide area.

We started by concentrating on the dances taught by Anat at Stone Cross, and those culled from Gideon [Kalanit] and Pat's extensive repertoire, as well as some of Roberto [Haddon's] 'gems', together with a sprinkling of 'golden oldies'. As the group has grown, new 'volunteer dance leaders' have brought us dances from other sources, so that there are always more dances offered than we can hope to do in the time, even when we use winter afternoons as well as evenings.

Inevitably, with so many 'chiefs', there are occasional discussions about steps, but on the whole, the spirit of co-operative sharing prevails, and each occasion is an uplifting (and often exhausting) experience.

We are hoping to entice Roberto to come down to the wilds of Sussex in the near future (hint, hint, Roberto!) to do an afternoon for us, and if we are successful, will let you know for the diary. In the meantime, we welcome anyone with a modicum of experience of Israeli dance, whether they can come regularly or only occasionally, and can promise a friendly reception.
