Cambridge International Club

We are sorry to announce that International Folk Dancing at Cambridge International Club will cease with a final dance on Monday 25th September.

In 1954 some members of Cambridge International Club decided to start a Folk Dance group (as an alternative to Ballroom Dancing and jiving to pop music). The group met at the Friends' Meeting House, where my mother was warden, and I remember as a young teenager going to sleep listening to exotic folk dance music on a Monday night. It always ended with Mayim Mayim which has been our traditional last dance of the evening ever since.

By the time I joined the group, learning the dances to the familiar tunes, in 1958 the numbers attending had exceeded the capacity of the Meeting House hall and the group had moved to a larger hall at St. Columba's Church where we have met ever since. Over the next decades the group flourished with attendances of 40, or more, young people about half of whom were from overseas (mainly, but by no means all, from Language Schools). For a period we even ran a second evening on Wednesdays. We ran Folk Dance evenings at several Language Schools and even, for a time, had a display team (because of the variety of dances we did deciding on suitable costumes was a problem!).

From about 1990 numbers started to decline, particularly of younger dancers, until we are now reduced to a core group of only 5 British geriatrics. Gone are the days when we thought the teacher was old when he celebrated his 30th birthday, it's some time since we had any dancers under 30!

So we have decided to throw in the sponge. We hope any past members, and indeed any SIFD members, will join us on 25 September to make our last dance go with a swing. (for info. Email *Patrick.schicker@btinternet.com*)
