Ever since I met Rami Schaafi and invited him to the Eastbourne festival Mongolian throat singing (Khoumi) has fascinated me. I have recently discovered a heavy metal folk rock band called "The Hu" and just cannot stop listening to their music. One of the traditional instruments they play is the Morin Khuur, (horsehead fiddle - see page12). The Mongolian word 'hu' is the root for 'hun' (person), 'huu' (child) and 'humuun' (human). 

Following the Committee's item in the February News, which included the proposed course of action if sufficient help is volunteered, it is hoped that the project will be advanced without delay.


Conversion of SIFD to a Charitable Incorporated Organisation. The first step is to draft a revised Constitution, and this is in hand.

Nutbrook International Folk Dance Group are hosting a weekend of International Dance to celebrate 40 years of the group's existence. On September 28th and 29th in Bramcote Village, Nottinghamshire. The majority of the events will be held in the Memorial Hall with just the Saturday morning sessions in St Michael's Church Hall. The two halls are next door to each other so the move from one to the other will be fine.

The teacher on this occasion will be Mariette van Gelder from whom we have learnt some lovely dances in the past. There will also be a session for revising and enjoying dances from over the decades (many of which we have kept active in our repertoire). We will have a special buffet followed by an evening dance on the Saturday and more dancing on the Sunday.

There are various places in the area with good accommodation. Whitely Mill Hotel in Stapleford is perhaps the cheapest - room only, no food. There are the usual chains - Best Western near junction 25 of M1, the Risley Hotel & Spa (expensive on Saturday nights) and various B & B places and a Travelodge at Wollaton Park which has been used on previous occasions. This one is now on the same site as a Miller & Carter steak house.

If you fancy a long weekend away there are nearby attractions such as Wollaton Hall and Attenborough Nature Reserve, while further away there are many sights and walking opportunities in Sherwood Forest and the Peak District of Derbyshire.

Our workshop, entitled "A World Tour" attracted 30 participants from all over Yorkshire, and consisted of a 90-minute programme of varied dances taught by Lorna Ramsden and Lynda Shaw to recorded music, interspersed with some live accordion music from me.

The event was successful for both our Group (several of our leaflets disappeared!) and for the Charity, which raised around £5,000 from their efforts. It was good to see a sprinkling of younger dancers enjoying our programme, so that bodes well for the future of our Society, we hope.

An internet search needs to be for 'ahavat hadasa (r.s.)' and will bring up both (with just one 's' in hadasa).

On the Rokdim website itself (www.rokdim.co.il - click on the US flag at the top of the screen to view the site in English) you can search for specific dances and find links to similar video clips on YouTube or on the site itself. Some of the transliterations of dances names might be different to those commonly used in the UK though.
