Obviously **Korobushka** has been known to the Society for many years, but my introduction to it came from Hennie Konings on his first visit to Eastbourne. He has, in fact, taught it on every occasion I have invited him; it must be a favourite with him. (Or perhaps he was persisting until we got it right)

Here are my notes:

jaunty Mixer dance -

couples in a circle facing a/cw - cross handhold

side Right, close Left, side Right, touch Left. side Left, close Right, side Left, touch Right. side Right, close Left, side Right, touch Left. stamp LRL, touch Right - face partner hold R. hand arm's length

R.L.R forwards, LRL back, R.L.R forwards, LRL back walk 4 steps to change places, *turning lady under* then 3 stamps and touch L.

All side Right, close Left, side Right, touch Left. *nod to next* All side Left, close Right, side Left, touch R

R.L.R forwards, LRL back, R.L.R forwards, LRL back walk 4 steps to change places, *turning lady under* then men forward, ladies greet next partner
